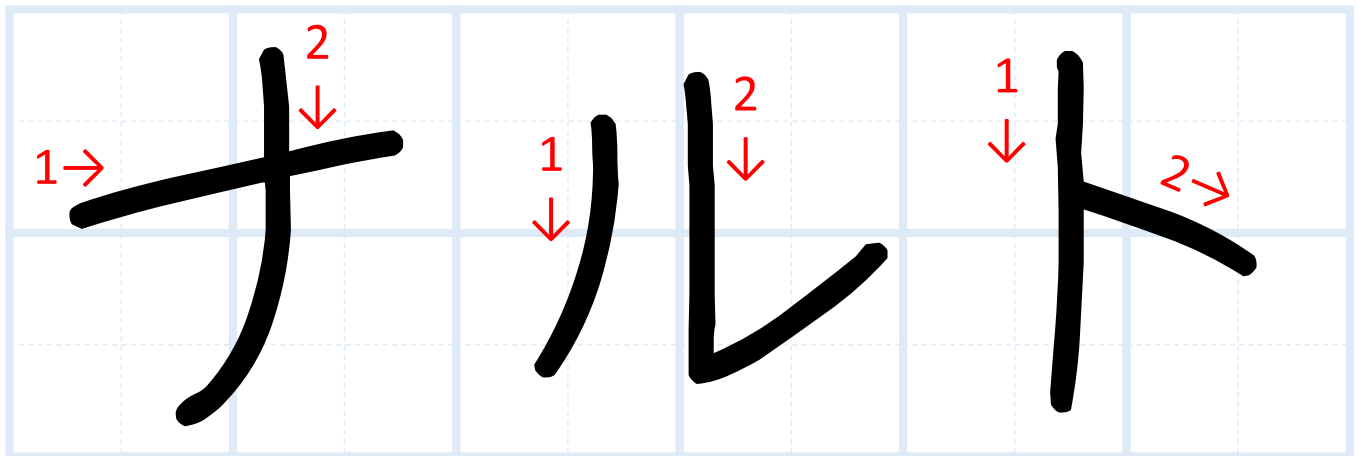


# MISSION 1. Let's Practice NARUTO!

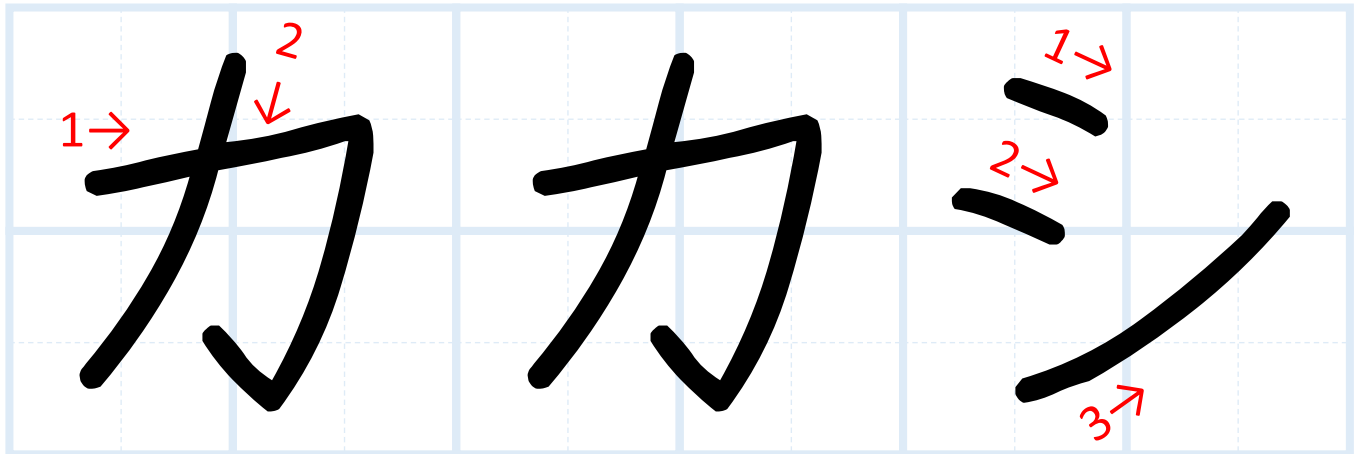


## MISSION 2. Let's Practice KAKASHI!

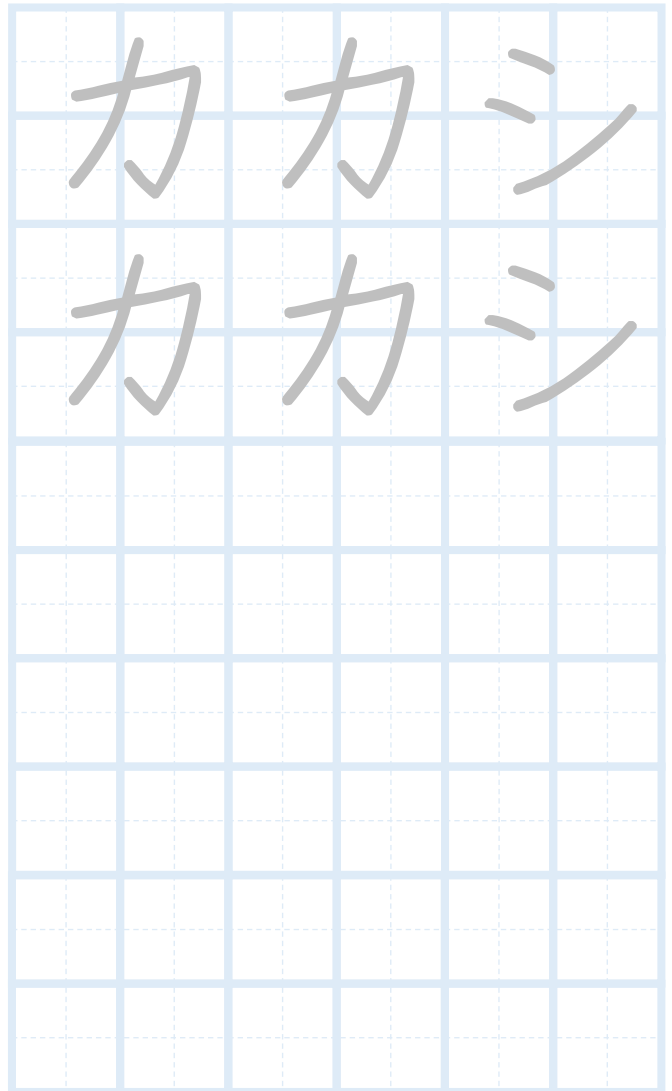
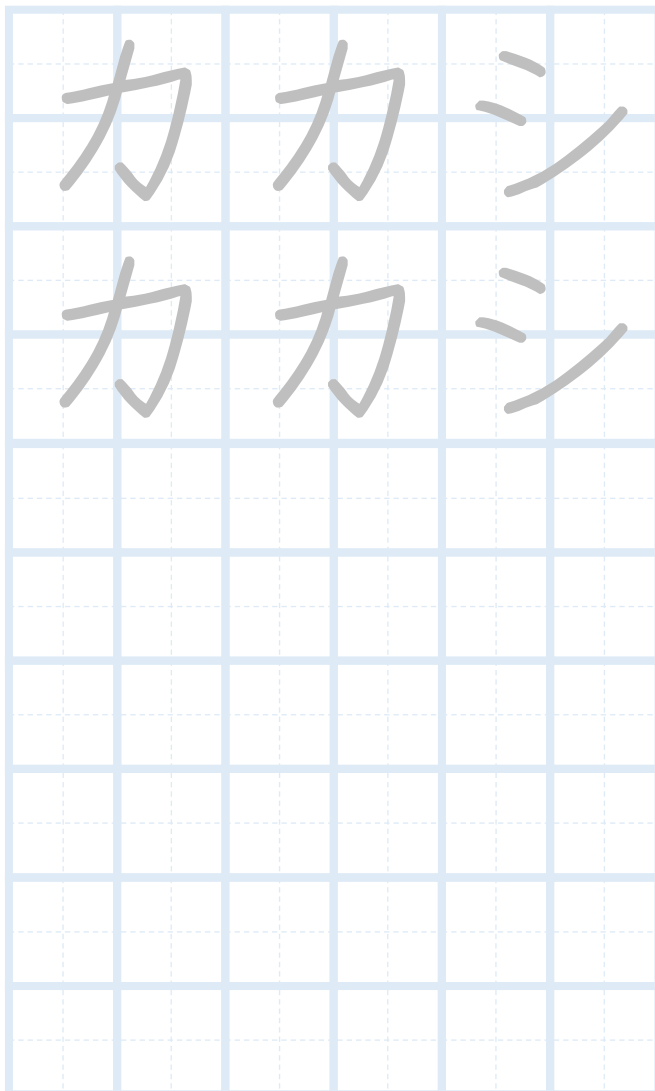

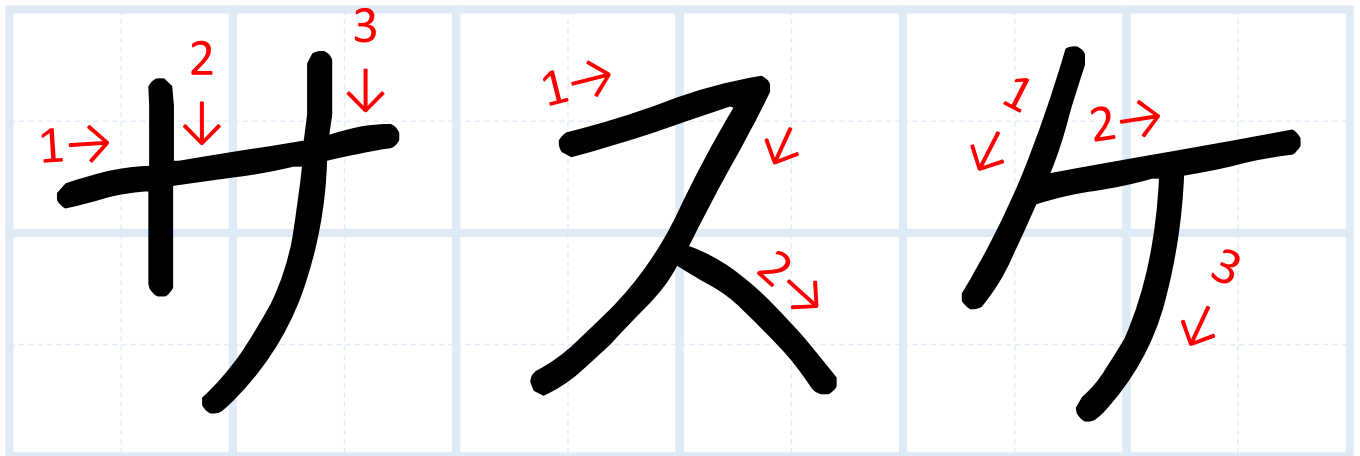


# MISSION 3. Let's Practice SASUKE!

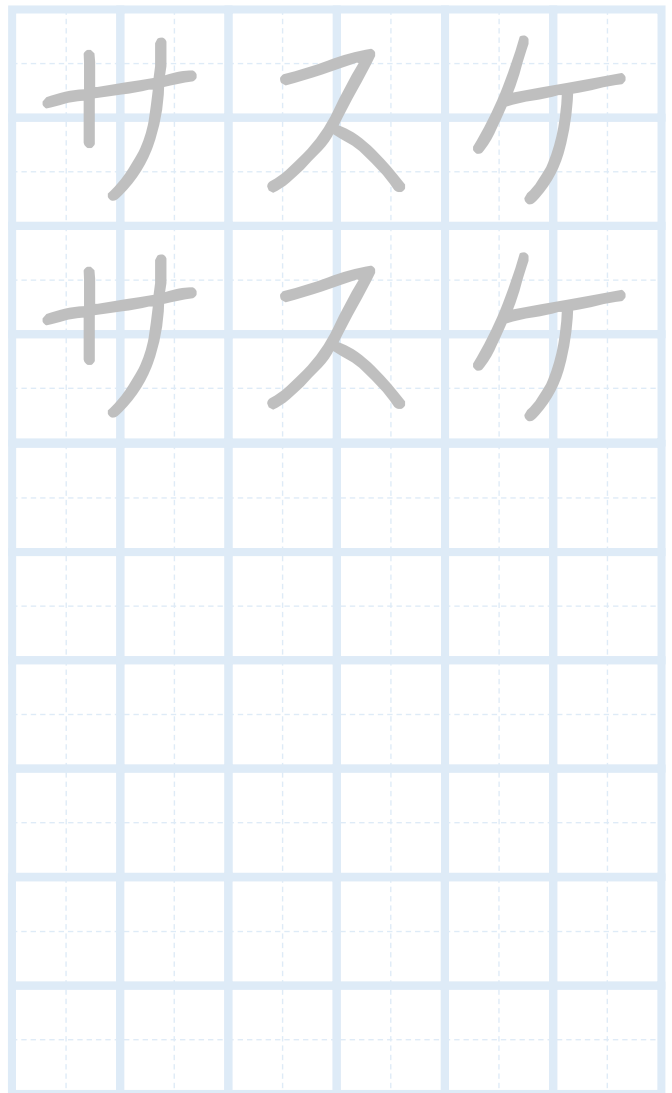
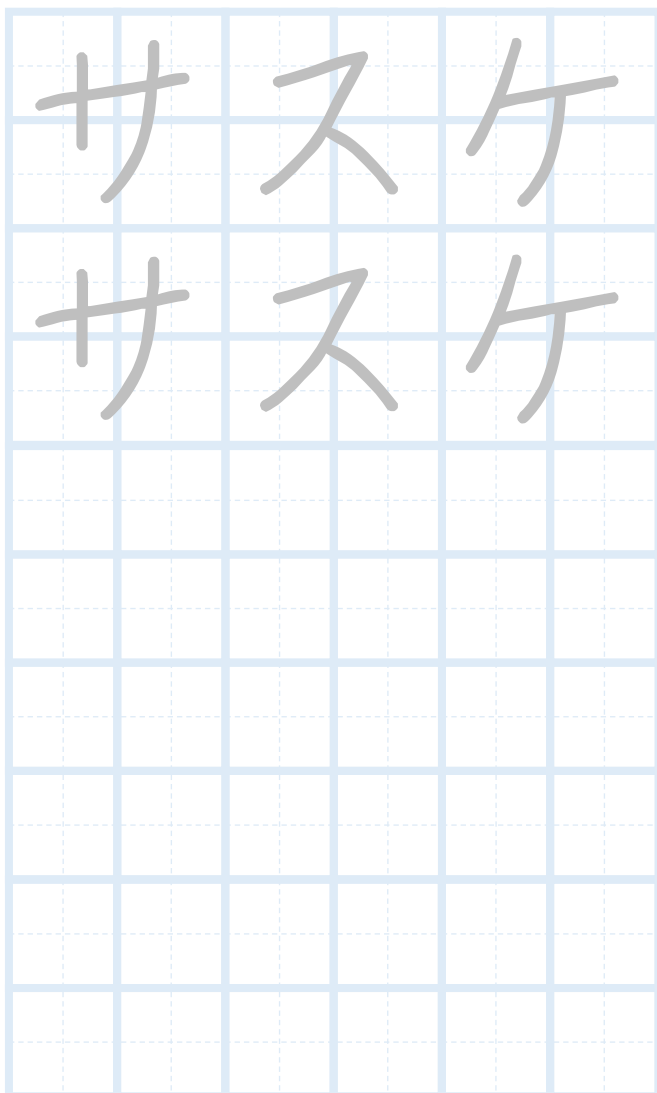

SASUKE is the name of the Ninja that really existed in Japanese history. His name is one of the most Ninja-ish ones among all NARUTO characters!

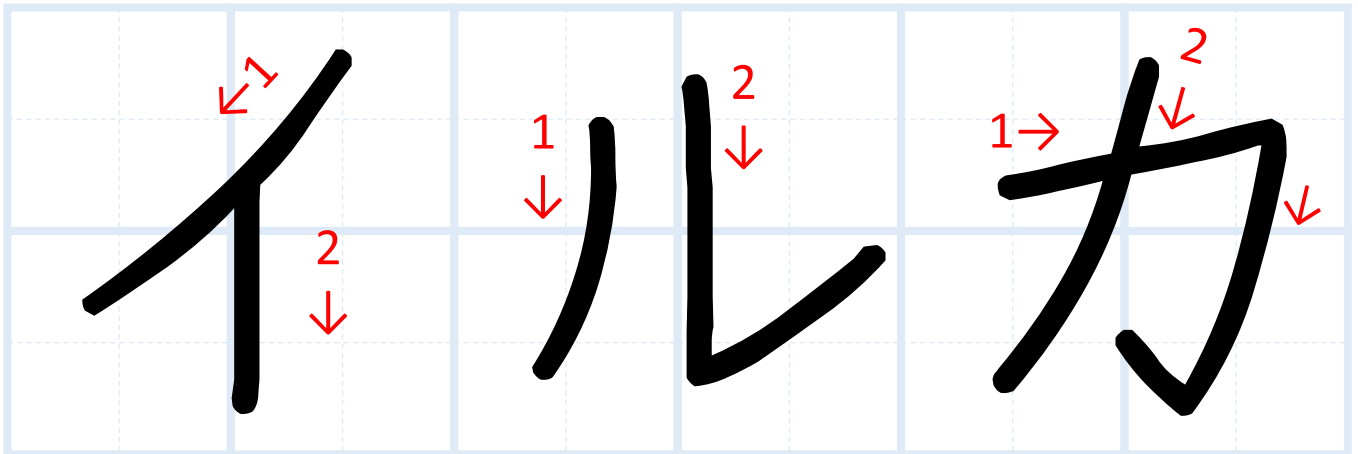


# MISSION 4. Let's Practice IRUKA!

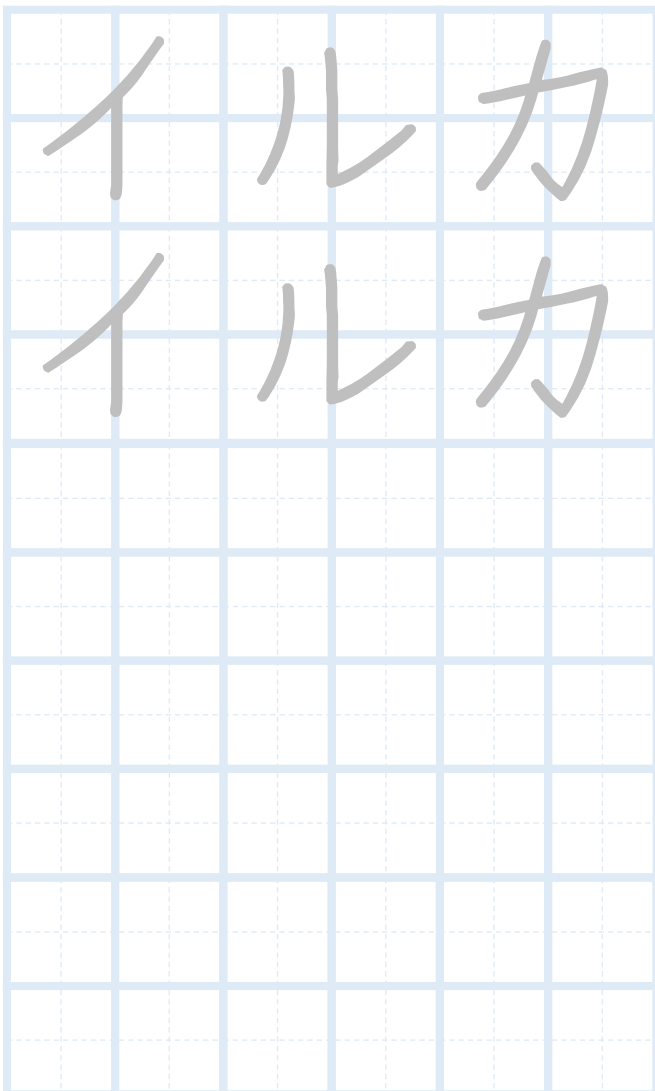

IRUKA means a dolphin. Teacher Iruka's family name UMINO's UMI stands for "sea". His name is associated with a dolphin swimming in the sea!

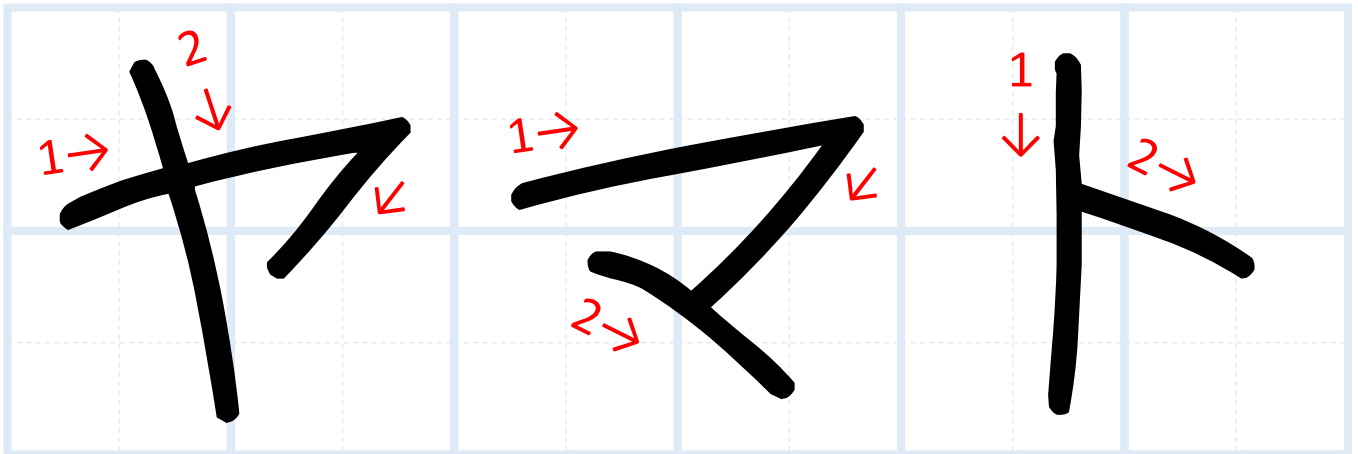


# MISSION 5. Let's Practice YAMATO!
